

**PROPOSED BYLAW AMENDMENTS FOR ATU LOCAL 241  
ELECTION DATE JUNE 4, 2007**

**AMENDMENT NO. 1**

**ACTION: Change**

Section	Current language	Proposed language
4	<p>The officers of this Local Union shall be a President who is also the Business Agent, two (2) Vice Presidents, a Recording and Corresponding Secretary, a Financial Secretary-Treasurer, an Assistant Business Agent-Maintenance, and an Executive Board to consist of one (1) member from stations, garages or work locations having four hundred (400) members or less and two (2) members from station, garages or work locations having between four hundred and one (401) and eight hundred (800) members. Two (2) members from the General Office, three (3) members from the Repair Department, one (1) North, one (1) Central, and one (1) South. One (1) member from the Station Clerks, one (1) member from Transportation Supervisors and Instructors, one (1) member from the Pace Heritage Division and one (1) member from the Pace West Division. There shall be delegates to the Chicago Federation of Labor and Industrial Union Council, the Illinois Federation of Labor.</p>	<p>The officers of Local Union 241 shall be full-time and shall consist of a President who is also the Business Agent, two (2) Vice Presidents, a Recording and Corresponding Secretary, a Financial Secretary-Treasurer, an Assistant Business Agent-Maintenance, and an Executive Board to consist of one (1) members from stations, garages or work locations from 103<sup>rd</sup> St. Garage, 77<sup>th</sup> St. Garage, 74<sup>th</sup> St. Garage, Archer Garage, Kedzie Garage, Chicago Ave. Garage, North Park Garage and Forest Glen Garage. One (1) member from General Office, two (2) members from Maintenance Department, one (1) North and one (1) South. One (1) member from Transportation Supervisor and Instructors and one (1) member from Pace West. There shall be delegates to the Chicago Federation of Labor and Industrial Union Council, and the Illinois Federation Labor.</p>

26(e)	<p>(e) Executive Board Members shall, for the faithful performance of their duties, receive One-Hundred Thirty-Six Dollars (\$136.00) per day for working for the Local Union. They shall receive all increases won through collective bargaining. To compensate them for extra duties performed they shall receive two (2) extra day's pay per month. They shall receive Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75.00) per month for miscellaneous expenses.</p>	<p>(e) Executive Board Members, for the faithful performance of their duties, receive the sum of sixty thousand dollars (\$60, 000). They each shall receive seventy-five (\$75.00) per month for miscellaneous expenses. They shall receive all increases won through collective bargaining. They shall receive the same vacations as won in collective bargaining.</p>

28(g)	<p>(g) The names of all candidates who have qualified will be placed on the ballots in alphabetical order. Candidates for the Executive Board will be placed on the ballots in alphabetical order under the station to which they belong, and the stations shall be placed on the ballots in alphabetical order which shall be as follows: Archer, Central Repair, Forest Glen, General Office, Kedzie, Lawndale, Limits, North Park, Repair Department North, Repair Department South, Seventy-Seventh, Sixty-Ninth, 103<sup>rd</sup>, Station Clerks, Supervisor and Instructors, Pace Heritage and Pace West.</p>	<p>(g) The names of all candidates who have qualified will be placed on the ballots in alphabetical order under the station to which they belong, and the stations shall be placed on the ballots in alphabetical order which shall be as follows: Archer, Chicago, Forest Glen, General Office, Kedzie, Maintenance North, Maintenance South, North Park, 103<sup>rd</sup> St., 74<sup>th</sup> St., 77<sup>th</sup> St., Supervisor and Instructors and Pace West. The stations eligible to vote for Assistant Business Agent-Maintenance are Maintenance Department North and Maintenance Department South.</p>
